**ROLL CALL**

Chairman Bailey called the meeting to order at 5:15 P.M. Theresa Scott, David Mosby and Danny Whitson were absent. Mr. Whitson notified the Legal Department in advance of his absence.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

**APPLICATIONS FOR NEW BEER PERMITS AND ASSOCIATED MANAGER APPROVALS**

5th & Nine Vape Co. (Application #1553 – Class C, On-Premises Consumption)

Mr. Landon Brackett was present to discuss his On-Premises application. Chairman Bailey had some concern that Mr. Brackett did not have any experience with the selling of beer. Mr. Brackett assured Chairman Bailey that being in the Vape business, he is already familiar with the checking of ID's. Citizens must be at least eighteen years old upon entering the vape shop, then will be ID' d again before serving them beer. Mr. Brackett plans to serve bottled beer in the separated lounge area of the business. The lounge area will be blocked off to ensure that no one wanders into that area without being ID' d. Mr. Brackett also plans to reach out to local organizations to gather more information and materials to ensure no one is being sold beer under age or over-served.

Having no problems with this application, Secretary Doolittle moved for approval, seconded by Mr. Cantrell. The motion carried unanimously.

Chill Stop Market (Application #1557 – Class B, Off-Premises Consumption)

Mr. Jaymin Patel was present to discuss the On-Premises application. Mr. Patel explained details about the business such as the hours of operation, amount of employees, and types of training the staff will have access to. Chairman Bailey also explained that there are tools to help identify with fake ID's or if

there is any question in doubt with an ID. Mr. Patel stated that he has worked in a variety of convenience stores and is familiar with the checking of ID's. Chairman Bailey noted that there have not been any noted issues in the previous convenience stores Mr. Patel has managed, and he commends him on his effort on safely selling beer.

Having no problems with this application, Secretary Doolittle moved for approval, seconded by Mr. Cantrell. The motion carried unanimously.
