Ms. Naomi Asher was present to discuss the Special Event Application for the upcoming festival “Taste of Anderson County.” Ms. Asher noted that this was the third year hosting the festival with both beer and liquor present. There have not been any issues with beer sales in the past. Last year they had roughly three hundred and fifty people in attendance. Although, since the festival is spread out over a five hour time span, there was usually only 100-150 people there at one time. United Way expects to have roughly ten food vendors at the festival. Also, Ms. Asher made note that Crafter’s Brew will debut their Bus Depot at the festival! For security purposes, they will have both entry and exit ways closed off to ensure no one leaves the premises with a beverage in hand. They also plan to use hands stamps to separate people who are of drinking-age and those who are not.

Having no problems with this application, Ms. Scott moved for approval, seconded by Mr. Whitson. The motion carried unanimously.
