  - c. Non-member guests: Marion Burger with the League of Women Voters
3. Approval of the Agenda, Announcements, and Citizen Input
  - a. Motion to approve the Agenda was made by Mr. Kennedy, seconded by Ms. Bogard. Motion passed.
4. Review and approval of Minutes of the January 7, 2016 Meeting

5. Unfinished Business
  - a. 2015 EQAB Annual Report: Mr. Kenworthy initiated discussion on reviewing 2015 EQAB Highlights and 2016 Priorities.
