The City of Oak Ridge will hold two public hearings to gain citizen input on needs and potential projects, which may be eligible under the CDBG Entitlement Program for the period of July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014 (PY13/FY14). Suggestions for potential projects will be solicited, both verbally and in writing, from all interested parties. CDBG Entitlement funds for PY13/FY14 are expected to total approximately \$225,000.00. These funds must meet a HUD National Objective and benefit low/moderate income (LMI) individuals.

Citizens are encouraged to attend the public hearing and to provide suggestions to the City staff for uses of the CDBG Entitlement funds. If unable to attend the hearing, please submit written comments, no later than October 20, 2012.

The first public hearing will begin at 12:00 p.m. (local time) on Thursday, October 11, 2012 and the second public hearing will be held at 5:00 p.m. (local time) on Monday, October 15, 2012 and both will be held at
