**Planning Commission:** Mr. Agle reported that there was not a regular meeting, but they held a special called meeting to approve a re-subdivision at the K-25 site.

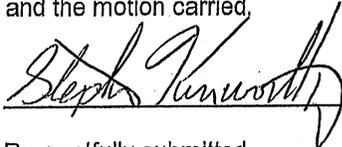
**Keep Anderson County Beautiful:** Ms. Imperato reported that the next Earth Day will be held on April 27, 2013.
