

HOMEOWNER ELECTRICAL PERMIT AFFIDAVIT

The City of Oak Ridge allows a homeowner to obtain electrical permits and do the electrical work on the dwelling in which he lives. The Oak Ridge Municipal Code, Title 12, Chapter 5, Section 12-502 (1) states:

The following persons shall not be required to have the license required by Section 12-502 (1):

Any person doing his own work personally, in a single-family dwelling used exclusively for living purposes, and who is the bona fide owner of and occupies or will occupy such dwelling, and who personally purchases all materials and performs all labor in connection therewith, shall not be required to have a license under the Electrical Code of the City of Oak Ridge. Such privilege does not convey the right to violate any of the provisions of this chapter, nor is it to be construed as exempting any such owner from obtaining a permit, except for minor repairs, and paying the required fees therefore.

The above article **does not** allow the homeowner to obtain a permit and have a co-worker, friend, relative, etc., do the work for them. As the homeowner, you are also responsible to make sure that all inspections are made prior to the concealing of the work by contacting the Code Enforcement office at 425-3532. Any violation of the above article can result in legal action.
